What is Creation Spirituality?

Creation spirituality reminds us that all creation is sacred. All that exists has emerged as an expression of God's word. The entire cosmos bears the design of God's Wisdom. Everything everywhere has been touched by God, the Creator (see Isaiah 6:3).

Not only is the Earth spiritual – filled with divine presence – but our Earth has a hidden impulse to reveal that presence to those willing to see, hear, feel, or discern it. If our spirit becomes sensitive to this Earth as God's sanctuary, we can become conscious of God's glory in every single aspect of creation. Earth is a sanctuary where the sacredness of all life is to be revered.

Made in the image and likeness of God, humans are in a unique position to respond to God's Spirit with a profound understanding of what it means to be linked to all that God has brought into being. All species have their purpose – all are meant to live in communion in a world where the aspiration of each one is to help bring fulfilment to the other. We are not here on this Earth to obtain what we can from it and from one another. Rather, we are here to enjoy all the earth has to offer, sharing that joy equally and only taking from the earth what is necessary for one's survival. The latter is the result of having a religious spirit that converts us to the earth; something this earth is in desperate need of.
